Daily Life in Chandler in the 1910s & 1920s



OVERVIEW

- ◆ Students explore life in Chandler one hundred years ago as they visit four interactive stations during a two hour guided trip. Stations include:
 - ◆ McCroskey House
 - ◆ Morrison Store
 - ◆ Entertainment at the Red Shed Theater
 - ◆ Cotton and Agriculture
- ◆ Field trips take place at Tumbleweed Ranch in Tumbleweed Park in Chandler (near Germann and McQueen)
- ◆ Field trips are offered for free but a \$1/person donation is appreciated
- ◆ Field trips are offered to schools for 1st through 4th graders. One hour abbreviated field trips are available to Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, and Home School groups (minimum of ten participants).
