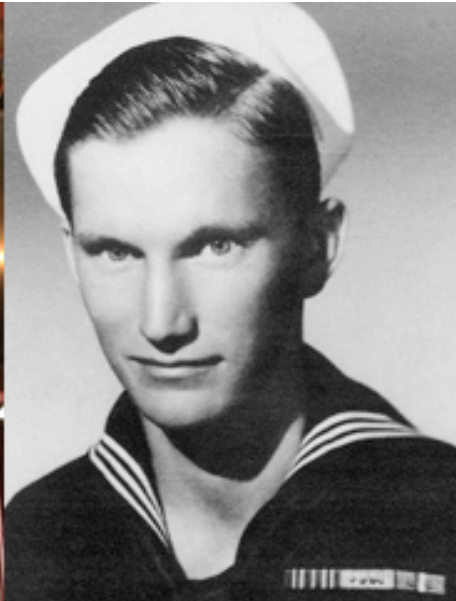




# WWII CHANDLER DISTRICT HONOR ROLL

In May 1943, at the height of World War II, the people of Chandler honored their hometown heroes who were serving their country by erecting an "Honor Roll" billboard downtown in [Dr. A.J. Chandler Park](#). The sign listed the names of men and women serving in the military who came to Chandler and small neighboring communities like Higley, Queen Creek, Chandler Heights and Goodyear.
